## COVID-19 TREATMENT FOR CAWEM MEMBERS

The Secretary of Health and Human Services has declared a State of Public Health Emergency for the United States due to the spread of novel coronavirus (COVID-19). As a result, the Oregon Health Authority (OHA) has determined that the Oregon Health Plan's (OHP) Citizen/Alien Waived Emergency Medical (CAWEM) benefit includes emergency services related to the coronavirus (COVID-19), regardless of your immigration status. This coverage includes facility and professional services in emergency rooms and subsequent hospitalizations when deemed appropriate and necessary.
