Where Can I Get Tested?

If you have insurance, you can contact your doctor or clinic to request a test.

If you don't have insurance, call 211 for help finding a clinic. You can also call the Health Department's Primary Care Clinics at 503.988.5558 to enroll as a new patient.

The following free test sites are open to all those with **COVID-19 symptoms and their close contacts.** People of color, people without health insurance or a regular health care provider will be prioritized.

Testing site hours or locations may change, and new sites may be added. Call for updates.
